Aldinga Payinthe College is a Department for Education Birth to Year 12 school delivered under a Public Private Partnership (PPP) model. The school has been designed as a community hub with a focus on universal access and connection to Country through story telling. Ongoing programs for students supported by the local Elders further develop students connection to place, their learning and their community.

The Department for Education was a funding partner in the 'Schools as Community Hubs' three year Australian Research Council Linkage Project (2019-2022) to inform better design and sharing of school infrastructure that improves education and strengthens communities.
