New buildings have been carefully placed to maximise the available footprint of the site, including the street and a communal waiting area. The architects were faced with site constraints and challenging topography but created a rich and inviting terraced courtyard that doubles as both a performance space as well as an outdoor learning area.

This space is now known as the heart and focal point of the school. The outcome of this project is a harmonious blend of contrasting elements and play. The challenge of the topography which was once a hinderance is arguably the largest contributor of success, resulting in a multi-tiered and interconnected precinct.
