# Most Likely to SUCCEED



**“Why has our education system stayed the same while our economy has so drastically shifted due to changes in technology?”**

“Most Likely to Succeed”, a feature-length documentary, directed by acclaimed documentarian Greg Whiteley, asks precisely this question. Examining the history of education, the film focuses on provoking audiences to rethink and redefine schooling to be relevant for the contemporary world in which we live. The narrative describes the nature of how the workplace and workforce have changed and require schooling to produce individuals who are equipped with sets of skills that a traditional educational model is not providing.

**The partner event** will be a tour of **Living Faith Primary School at North Lakes** on the **14th of March.**


