The Hanly Learning Centre is located prominently at the centre of the college — a move that raises the profile of academia in a sports-driven secondary boys' school. The performative nature of teaching and learning is heightened through a variety of settings and use of a theatre-like backdrop.

There is a large common area for social learning, community gatherings and structured academic events. This space is flanked by the Library, which is distributed across three interconnected levels with a variety of learning settings.

There are spaces to suit individual study, small groups and classes in a variety of modes including collaboration, contemplation, didactic teaching and incidental learning. Students benefit from the co-location of complementary learning and support facilities such as the library, the Learning and Teaching department, classrooms and cafeteria.
